Section 201(3)	Violation of the privacy of the spoken word
Section 203(2) (4) (5)	Violation of private secrets
Section 204	Exploitation of the secrets of another
Sections 331, 332	Taking advantages; taking bribes meant as an incentive for violating one's official duties
Section 335	Especially serious cases of taking and giving bribes
Section 336	Omission of official act
Section 338	Confiscatory expropriation order and extended forfeiture
Section 353(b)	Breach of official secrets and special duties of confidentiality
Section 358	Ancillary measures
Section 97b (2) i.c.w. Sections 94 to 97	Disclosure based on mistaken assumption that secret is illegal
Section 120(2)	Facilitating escape of prisoners
Section 355	Violation of the tax secret
